## Tournament Rules

The following rules shall apply and will be enforced. Interpretation and enforcement of these rules shall be left exclusively to the tournament director or his designee. In the event of a rule violation, the tournament director may impose such sanctions, as he deems appropriate, including, without limitation, disqualification, and forfeiture of prizes, and/or entry fees. The decision of the tournament director and/or his designee shall be final in all matters.

1. Check in time for the tournament begins at **5:00 am on August 22, 2009** at the State Park Launch Ramp. Pre launch meeting will start at 6:00am. *All competitors are required to attend.*
2. The tournament is open to any competitor 16 years of age or older. Proof of age is the sole responsibility of the potential competitor.
3. A properly completed and signed entry form and entry fees must be received by Bill's Outdoor Center tournament by mail no later than **August 15, 2009**. ENTRY FEE WILL ONLY BE REFUNDED IF PROPER NOTIFICATION IS MADE TO TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR NO LESS THAN 7 DAYS PRIOR TO TOURNAMENT. ***Entries will be accepted the morning of the tournament (up until 6:00am) with no penalty.***
4. Bill's Outdoor Center reserves the right to change, modify rules and regulations as well as DENY ANY APPLICATION FOR ANY REASON.
5. The tournament is limited to largemouth and smallmouth bass only.
6. Minimum length shall be 12 inches, as measured on a FLATBOARD, with fish in its NATURAL POSITION, mouth closed. Short fish will be removed and a 1 lb penalty will be assessed to total weight and lunker.
7. Each team may weigh in a total of 5 fish.
8. CATCH AND RELEASE: For each dead bass presented at weigh in, the competitor shall be penalized the following deductions: .50 (1/2 lb) from total weight per dead fish. All fish weighed become property of Bill's Outdoor Center to be released back to Deep Creek Lake.
9. Ties will be broken by the team with the heaviest fish, if tie still exists the prize money will be combined and split evenly between both teams.
10. All contestants must fish from a boat and may not leave the boat except in emergencies. STATE PARK BOAT RAMP and BILL'S OUTDOOR CENTER have been established as in bounds for such emergencies and you must check in with a tournament official.
11. A designated tournament official must be granted access to a competitor's boat at any time. Failure to grant permission is grounds for immediate disqualification.
12. Fishing within 50 yards of another competitor's boat is prohibited unless granted by that competitor.
13. Trolling as a method of fishing is prohibited.
14. No live or prepared baits, except pork, will be permitted. ARTIFICIAL BAIT ONLY.
15. The use of alcohol and/or drugs during the tournament is prohibited.
16. Coast Guard approved life vests must be worn and kill switches attached when gas engine is running.
17. All participants agree to abide by all boating laws of Deep Creek Lake.
18. Your tournament starting position WILL BE IN ORDER OF REGISTRATION. Leave the assembly area in order of entry number, and you have been given the signal to go from the tournament director. ALL BOATS MUST GO BY THE DIRECTOR SO THEY CAN RECORD YOUR NUMBER; IF THEY DO NOT RECORD YOUR NUMBER YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO WEIGH IN. (This will be explained in meeting).
19. Identification numbers, # Tokens and ribbon will be handed out the morning of the tournament and must be available for display at all times during the tournament.
20. The tournament is officially over at 2:30 pm (Unless flights become necessary, in which it will be explained in meeting). You must turn your pill into a tournament official by no later than specified time. At that time weigh in will be started. LATE PENALTY WILL BE 1 POUND PER MINUTE DEDUCTED FROM TOTAL WEIGHT AND LUNKER BASS.

21. Any rule infractions/protests must be reported to the tournament official for **review before the weigh in closes in writing.**
22. All participants will be subject to a polygraph test and WILL ABIDE BY THE DECISION OF THE TOURNAMENT OFFICIAL to take the test and pass or forfeit their winnings.
23. FAILURE TO OBSERVE THESE RULES IS GROUNDS FOR IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION.
